 Gaya Ethaniel: I read some translating into 'bliss' compared to joy [piti] that comes under mental formations.

 Eliza Madrigal: oh, interesting!
 stevenaia Michinaga: the joy of giving, not receiving
 Mickorod Renard: if its feeling well from seeing others happy maybe thats something we relate to?
 Gaya Ethaniel: So mudita is not joy as one would normally understand.
 Gaya Ethaniel: Hello Ewan :)

Eliza Madrigal: Hi Ewan :)

stevenaia Michinaga: this would be unselfish joy.. to me

Avy Runner: hi Ewan :)

Gaya Ethaniel: Yes and also perhaps grounded.

Eliza Madrigal: yes... that makes sense too...unconditioned joy

Eliza Madrigal: well, so intention seems key... 'where' it is coming from...

Gaya Ethaniel: So I'd say one wouldn't be swept away from mudita.

Ewan Bonham: Hi Zen

Gaya Ethaniel: swept away by*

Eliza Madrigal: there is a little children's book I read to my kids called 'rainbow fish' and this fish is so beautiful... has the loveliest scales... everyone meets the fish and admires the scales and ask for one but the fish is afraid "if I give them away I won't be special anymore".... at the end he finds out all of life is special and he loves everyone having one of his scales

Avy Runner: or sometimes we find ourselves in the kind of place where we know more

Gaya Ethaniel: So he got nakkid :P

Zen Arado: not zero sum

Gaya Ethaniel: Loving-kindness could be seen as boundless perhaps?

Eliza Madrigal: ! true wealth

Ewan Bonham: That is the easiest for me...love is clearly something that grows when I give it away..

Gaya Ethaniel: This bit from Zen's report caught my eye - I sometimes feel a little guilty if I don't feel much in the way of sympathetic joy towards people when the occasion seems to demand it

Mickorod Renard: for sure

Avy Runner: learning the source of giving away, while doing it

Eliza Madrigal: Nice

Zen Arado: it's when I feel I 'should' feel it i don't like

Eliza Madrigal: doesn't one have to 'risk' them'self' ... ? this is why I linked it to renunciation and devotion...

Zen Arado: guess I'm a rebel

Gaya Ethaniel: Well I'm happy for anyone happily getting married ... beyond that, not sure I feel the pressure as you described it Zen.

Eliza Madrigal: :)

Ewan Bonham: The 'should' ...that would make it difficult to give, would it not?

Zen Arado: that engagement seems such a nin event to me

Zen Arado: non*

Gaya Ethaniel shrugs ... understandable.

Eliza Madrigal: maybe that's part of the resentment sometimes, if one is made to feel they should it is like not giving credit to their own natural response that they will... 'be happy for' etc

Zen Arado: maybe because I am not in favour of Royalty

Mickorod Renard: maybe this is another route towards loving ourselves a bit more too

Eliza Madrigal: hmm

Ewan Bonham: And discovering the love that resides within us..

Gaya Ethaniel: You mean nourishing ourselves Mick?

Zen Arado: think it is an anachronistic institution

Zen Arado: but just my opinion

Mickorod Renard: yes, without knowing it

Gaya Ethaniel: :)

Avy Runner: I think so Mick

Eliza Madrigal: nice idea Mick

Zen Arado: loving kindness to ourselves

Zen Arado: first

Avy Runner: loving kindness to others radiating on ourselves?

Eliza Madrigal: or through loving others...

Mickorod Renard: Stim used to suggest I should love myself more,,and it sounded selfish for me to do so,,but for sure, I recognise a feeling of well being when I feel happy for others

Eliza Madrigal: Ah, nice Avy

Avy Runner: *radiating

Gaya Ethaniel: :)

Zen Arado: I had a realization about sympathetic joy

Zen Arado: but forget what it was

Eliza Madrigal: yes I remember that Mick... your struggle a bit...

Mickorod Renard: :)

Zen Arado: something along those lines Mick

Gaya Ethaniel: I think when one practice loving kindness, the line between me and others blur ... so benefits would be for all.

Eliza Madrigal: seems to go back to no zero sum

Eliza Madrigal: yes

Avy Runner: yes (Gaya)

Eliza Madrigal: just being open, in some sense, just not withholding what is

Gaya Ethaniel: When we are content and happy, we would share more of those with others and also take pleasure in others' happiness as well.

Ewan Bonham: openness can be a natural form of expressing love as well>)

Gaya Ethaniel: Yes :)

Avy Runner: right

Eliza Madrigal: mmm, nods

Zen Arado: jealousy is the big stopper

Eliza Madrigal: yes, what when we are not happy... or not 'feeling' happy... the out from that can be to take pleasure in others' happiness...

Zen Arado: why do we feel jealous?

Gaya Ethaniel: Partly to do with acceptance?

Eliza Madrigal: yes and fear

stevenaia Michinaga: a choice that is difficult to change

Zen Arado: selfishness

Avy Runner: I think that can be both ways Eliza, sometimes feeling joy for others helps us, sometimes we need to concentrate on our own unhappiness

Eliza Madrigal: yes, I see what you mean Avy, interesting point

Zen Arado: they say you can't love others until you love yourself

Eliza Madrigal: I find that even when I 'think' there is nothing to give, there is, then I feel like I have something to give...

Mickorod Renard: I am not sure Zen

Eliza Madrigal: which is pleasureable :)

Mickorod Renard: maybe it should be 'you can't love others without loving yourself

Gaya Ethaniel: :)

Avy Runner: hmmm, sounds good Mick :)

Ewan Bonham: And sometimes when i feel sadness, then giving OF myself becomes giving TO myself..)

Eliza Madrigal: when I am really miserable, I gather donations....

Gaya Ethaniel: Any excuse to have fun :P

Zen Arado: you can share their joy

Eliza Madrigal: :)

Mickorod Renard: I recently wondered something though,,to be balanced shouldnt we carry a little sadness as well as joy?

Gaya Ethaniel: :)

Avy Runner: so why is misery not real then Ewan?

Eliza Madrigal: I was bah humbug about shopping last year.... stim said (can) see mall as mandala...

Eliza Madrigal: :)

Zen Arado: :)

Zen Arado: hard to do :)

Ewan Bonham: nod Eliza..

Gaya Ethaniel: Today's topic joy isn't pleasure that is emotions like sadness.

Eliza Madrigal: interesting question too mick... sadness makes room for joy....

Gaya Ethaniel: It's not a state per se.

Ewan Bonham: Avy, I am still wrestling with that...and..i would say love is our natural state..)

Eliza Madrigal: Eos sometimes talks about the 'genuine mind of sadness'.... in Trungpa's teachings there is this idea of a kind of nostalgia for the present....

Zen Arado: if you love someone sympathetic joy is easy ?

Zen Arado: yes - no good pretending you don't feel what you feel...

Eliza Madrigal: not sure... what when you love them and their good news takes them farther away zen?

Avy Runner: I'm wrestling with it too Ewan, but can't see why one is real and the other isn't

Eliza Madrigal: so you are happy for them but there is a sadness too...

Mickorod Renard: yes

Zen Arado: hmmm.. yes Eliza

Mickorod Renard: one cannot see without sensitivity

Eliza Madrigal: yes, hmmm

Eliza Madrigal: even in our own good news and joy there is sadness for others we maybe can't take with us... or feel we can't

Avy Runner: hmmmm yes

Zen Arado: if someone leaves you in a relationship should you find joy that they are happy with someone else?
