boxy (alfred.kelberry): wuff! Bruce (bruce.mowbray): Hey Darren -- Hey Alfred! leaping panther (darren.islar): today I can sit normal:) boxy (alfred.kelberry): wuff! Gaya Ethaniel: hihi:) boxy (alfred.kelberry): hi:) leaping panther (darren.islar): hi Gaya:) boxy (alfred.kelberry): cute bunny:) Bruce (bruce.mowbray): /me thinks: These chairs are like a leash. boxy (alfred.kelberry): ok, i'll settle here near the bottle of wine Gaya Ethaniel: heheh boxy (alfred.kelberry): leash? leaping panther (darren.islar): only if you want to pass it on boxy:) boxy (alfred.kelberry): sure thing:) Bruce (bruce.mowbray): It is an allusion to our earlier discussion, Al. Gaya Ethaniel: I know Atari won't be here. Dao and Mitsu probably can't make it either. boxy (alfred.kelberry): yes, bruce... i can see how it can be seen as a leash Gaya Ethaniel: Still let's give a few more minutes. boxy (alfred.kelberry): oh, are they alright? Bruce (bruce.mowbray): I cannot even wave at folks when they arrive. Gaya Ethaniel: Just busy:) Bruce (bruce.mowbray): /me sobs. boxy (alfred.kelberry): ok:) boxy (alfred.kelberry): gaya changed haircut:) Gaya Ethaniel: Well, how do you all feel about having a summer break in June? Some of us are away then. Gaya Ethaniel::) leaping panther (darren.islar): that's okay with me Bruce (bruce.mowbray): I'm cool with whatever folks want and need. boxy (alfred.kelberry): or we can make it free to come meetings Gaya Ethaniel: How about your needs Bruce?:) Bruce (bruce.mowbray): Hmmmmm. Bruce (bruce.mowbray): /me ponders his "needs." Gaya Ethaniel: We normally have a break but sure, that's another idea too Alfred. Bruce (bruce.mowbray): very few, actually. Gaya Ethaniel: At least I will be away for half of the meetings in June I think. Gaya Ethaniel::) Bruce (bruce.mowbray): /me also ponders empathy -- for self. boxy (alfred.kelberry)::) Gaya Ethaniel: Shall I send an email out? leaping panther (darren.islar): (btw, I mean the wine, you can keep the bone :)) Bruce (bruce.mowbray): sure, that's good, Gaya. Gaya Ethaniel: OK will do that. leaping panther (darren.islar): sure thing Bruce (bruce.mowbray): afk for just a moment. . . Gaya Ethaniel: So in case you didn't see, links for reports are here http://waysofknowing.kira.org/

Gaya Ethaniel: np

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): /me is back.

leaping panther (darren.islar): I have been away for a while, so I'm not sure what we have for discussion

right now

Gaya Ethaniel: wb

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): the topic is "empathy," Darren.

Gaya Ethaniel: We will be discussing empathy Darren.

leaping panther (darren.islar): thanks

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): ;-)

Gaya Ethaniel: Bruce (bruce.mowbray): For me, I am most "real" when I am able to empathize.

Calvino Rabeni: Well I agree, Bruce, but also interested in how that works

Fizakaal Wei: it allows you to let go of judgement

Calvino Rabeni: perhaps in subtle ways

Violet (ataraxia.azemus): I can relate to that

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): /me thinks -- Oh dear!

leaping panther (darren.islar): I see, interesting topic

Gaya Ethaniel::)

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): Empathy is my most authentic connection to the world, I feel.

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): (I really have no interest in "how it works," though.)

Gaya Ethaniel: heheh

Gaya Ethaniel: Well I'm not sure I can ever find out 'how it works'.

leaping panther (darren.islar): ponders empathy

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): but am happy to listen to others on that.

leaping panther (darren.islar): empathy seems to soften me up

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): /me loves the "softening."

Gaya Ethaniel::)

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): Hey, Zen!

leaping panther (darren.islar): but I guess it only exists because we start to care

boxy (alfred.kelberry): zen-san:)

leaping panther (darren.islar): hey Zen:)

Gaya Ethaniel: Yes I think most of us do care ...

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): Actually, I feel that we start to care after we soften. . .

Gaya Ethaniel: Hello Zen:)

leaping panther (darren.islar): most of all about ourselves, because we can only reach out if we

'understand'

Zen (zen.arado): Hi all

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): /me realizes once again that he's a real odd ball on this stuff.

leaping panther (darren.islar): /me wonders

leaping panther (darren.islar): :)

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): /me does everything backwards.

Gaya Ethaniel:?

Gaya Ethaniel: hm ... I may know what you mean by that Bruce ...

Gaya Ethaniel: Sometimes I feel that way too:)

leaping panther (darren.islar): :)

boxy (alfred.kelberry): egoistic traits are inherent in humans

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): The only work I ever do is on myself. . .

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): so, first I soften myself. . .

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): my judgments -- my comparisons....

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): and then I am able to ---

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): have the capacity to ---

leaping panther (darren.islar): to me it feels like the egg and chicken, it's like a rotating ball, care, softness, care, softness

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): feel empathy for others.

Zen (zen.arado): understand

boxy (alfred.kelberry): egg and chicken?:)

Zen (zen.arado): we put up a hard protective exterior

Zen (zen.arado): protects us

leaping panther (darren.islar): hmmm, that might be a Dutch expression, what came first, the egg or the chicken?

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): Unless I let go of my own shell -- there is little hope of my empathy . . .

Zen (zen.arado): but keeps others out

Gaya Ethaniel: Yes ... it's quite interesting.

leaping panther (darren.islar): /me nods at Bruce

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): So, empathy, for me, begins with empathy for oneself.

Zen (zen.arado): so empathy is also about opening?

boxy (alfred.kelberry): zen, my soc teacher used to say "armor around us":)

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): yes, Al.

Zen (zen.arado): yes

leaping panther (darren.islar): /me nods both at Bruce as Zen

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): There is great danger in "altruism" unless one first has empathy for one's own predicament.

boxy (alfred.kelberry): when we come home and take it off we become vulnerable

Gaya Ethaniel: Yes sort of operating from another plane so to speak ...

leaping panther (darren.islar): i think real empathy starts with the 'self' with realizing how hard it is to be 'perfect' and that we aren't with no means

leaping panther (darren.islar): so how to judge others if you see your own imperfections

boxy (alfred.kelberry): even in altruism there's an ego

boxy (alfred.kelberry): a person feels good about himself in helping others

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): Oh ESPECIALLY in altruism, Al!

boxy (alfred.kelberry)::)

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): I am SUCH a GOOD person -- because I take care of everyone --

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): but neglect my own work?

Gaya Ethaniel: I think sense of self is always there ... it's more about not operating from that narrow ground.

Zen (zen.arado): society teaches us to be competitive

Zen (zen.arado): does that reduce empathy?

Gaya Ethaniel: Yes ... should include everyone:)

leaping panther (darren.islar): I think that if you don't need anything in return, you can start to talk about true altruism

Zen (zen.arado): in a way a team spirit is empathy?

leaping panther (darren.islar): but that can be very tricky:)

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): Wonderful points, Darren.

boxy (alfred.kelberry): darren, you always get something

leaping panther (darren.islar): yes, that's actually what I mean boxy

Zen (zen.arado): empathy is the feeling that is before altruism

leaping panther (darren.islar): so I guess altruims starts with becoming aware of that

Gaya Ethaniel: That depends Zen, our team against another team also is being competitive: P

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): Regarding the recipients of one's altruism as "others" can only make the

"problems" worse....

Zen (zen.arado): empathy could be seen as weakness

Gaya Ethaniel: I think this is an interesting point that came up before Zen.

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): yes, weakness -- that's the "softening" part of it.

leaping panther (darren.islar): /me nods at Bruce, good point

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): but it is actually strength, of course.

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): to be strong enough to let others in.

Zen (zen.arado): if you need to fire someone you don't want empathy

Gaya Ethaniel: hm ...

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): why not?

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): what are you protecting there?

Zen (zen.arado): would make it more difficult

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): protecting?

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): of course firing someone is difficult --

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): but who asked for an easy path?

boxy (alfred.kelberry): darren, there's a kind of built-in mechanism that balances that - reciprocation. you

feel indebted if someone made a favor to you.

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): Mindfulness asks that you know their pain.

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): and also, perhaps, the opportunities that the firing offers for them....

Zen (zen.arado): yes...it's taking on the pain of others

leaping panther (darren.islar): /me looks up reciprocation

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): reciprocation is like getting back what you send out to others.

Zen (zen.arado): and the joy of others too of course

Gaya Ethaniel::)

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): like having it "both ways."

Zen (zen.arado): not all negative

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): nope.

 $leaping\ panther\ (darren. islar): /me\ nods\ at\ boxy,\ but\ I\ don't'\ think\ that\ is\ such\ a\ worse\ thing,\ except\ when$ 

you're not aware of it

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): can be wonderfully positive, also.

Zen (zen.arado): /me thinks empathy is natural

boxy (alfred.kelberry): bruce, some scholars argue that this is what actually made collaboration possible

Gaya Ethaniel: /me nods.

Zen (zen.arado): but we bury it

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): oh yes, it is natural -- It is how we have survived as a species.

leaping panther (darren.islar): to me awareness is so important, because we do have ego and we are not

perfect, but it's the awareness that has a softening effect

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): without empathy, we'd never had made it this far.

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): and we will not make it much farther unless we practice empathy,

Zen (zen.arado): it makes cooperation possible

Zen (zen.arado): which is good for survival

leaping panther (darren.islar): /me nods, but I think empathy is on more levels

leaping panther (darren.islar): there is the 'animal' level that sustains our species

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): /me ponders whether flatulence is good for survival.

leaping panther (darren.islar): what about the 'human' level

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): what do you mean, Darren?

leaping panther (darren.islar): I think there is an evolutionary empathy

leaping panther (darren.islar): and maybe one we can develop

Zen (zen.arado): how do you know you have empathy?

leaping panther (darren.islar): as a human

leaping panther (darren.islar): if you suffer:)

Zen (zen.arado): people with Asperger's are low in that

Gaya Ethaniel: Maybe when someone points out to you Zen:)

Zen (zen.arado): but you could be acting

Zen (zen.arado): that's what Aspergers people do

leaping panther (darren.islar): yes, but that could be well born out of empathy

Zen (zen.arado): they learn socially acceptable ways

 $\textit{Gaya Ethaniel: Sort of joking about that really } \dots \textit{I was on about how one just does stuff until someone } \\$ 

comes along and label them ... not so helpful sometimes.

leaping panther (darren.islar): though it's acting, they might do it not to harass others

boxy (alfred.kelberry): label them?

Zen (zen.arado): someone can tell you you are heartless

boxy (alfred.kelberry): zen, it's hard to find people who don't act

Zen (zen.arado): agree boxy

leaping panther (darren.islar): with different levels, maybe compassion is a good example, great love is something completely different then what we consider to be love in daily life

Gaya Ethaniel: Well what kind of 'action' ...

Zen (zen.arado): we all do it to an extent

boxy (alfred.kelberry): yes

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): /me does not feel that genuine empathy can be "acted."

leaping panther (darren.islar): it's not that we're doing it that is the problem, not seeing it is

Zen (zen.arado): but we can make it look as if we have it

boxy (alfred.kelberry): bruce, actors do that pretty well on camera:)

leaping panther (darren.islar): no Bruce but the acting can be part of empathy, not wanting to hurt others

Gaya Ethaniel: I mentioned helping someone on the street in my report.

boxy (alfred.kelberry): make me cry:)

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): yes, but it's not what I'm calling 'empathy.'

Gaya Ethaniel: It was pretty strange ...

leaping panther (darren.islar): the intention I mean

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): Ohhh-- good point, Darren.

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): we act because we don't want to hurt others --

Zen (zen.arado): we all like to give others a good impression

Zen (zen.arado): too

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): but that assumes we have a larger vision than those we are protecting - about what's good for them

boxy (alfred.kelberry): zen, more so, we act in accordance with what others see in us

Gaya Ethaniel: I mean our normal self just charges through the day ... I stopped really abruptly after what seemed like a long time, passing that person.

Gaya Ethaniel: So easy not to notice ...

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): /me has a really hard time in New York -- passing homeless folks on the sidewalk...

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): so he gives them money -- to help HIMSELF get past them... along his OWN way...

leaping panther (darren.islar): /me nods at Bruce, that's a hard question

boxy (alfred.kelberry): interesting, bruce

Zen (zen.arado): yeh and there are still homeless people there

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): I once encountered a homeless man on a mattress. . .

Gaya Ethaniel: In London too ... I sometimes see them getting insulted just for being homeless and being on the street.

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): right across the street from the Shambhala Center on 22nd St.

leaping panther (darren.islar): /me nods at Zen, they don't go away because you give them some money

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): and I paid him to tell me his story,...

boxy (alfred.kelberry): oh, bruce

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): and I profited so much more than he did from that!

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): (perhaps) -- I don't really know about him.

Zen (zen.arado): good idea Bruce

boxy (alfred.kelberry): can you tell us?

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): Well, I'd just come out for the meditation. . .

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): and crossed the street.

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): and there was this man on a mattress... on the sidewalk!

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): and I knelt down to talk with him. . .

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): and he seemed shy...

boxy (alfred.kelberry): how old was he?

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): and I said, I will pay you five dollars for every 5 minutes that you tell me about yourself.

leaping panther (darren.islar): maybe anxious

boxy (alfred.kelberry): wow

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): and he talked for about 20 minutes.

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): and it was the highlight of my trip to New York!

leaping panther (darren.islar): :)

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): He was perhaps 23, or so.

Gaya Ethaniel: :(

leaping panther (darren.islar): maybe it was his highlight of the day too

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): and he is black and I am white.

boxy (alfred.kelberry): can you say a few things from his story?

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): Mmmm....

boxy (alfred.kelberry): darren, i think so:)

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): not sure I can--- except that he was living one day at a time and collecting cans

from the streets and trash containers

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): to recycle.

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): and the next day was Memorial Day

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): and I was worried that he'd not be able to recycle the cans...

Zen (zen.arado): there is a fear that we might end up like that too

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): because of the holiday...

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): and he assured me that he could.

Zen (zen.arado): that is what people don't like

boxy (alfred.kelberry): yes, zen Gaya Ethaniel: Probably yes ...

leaping panther (darren.islar): yes Zen

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): /me listens.

Zen (zen.arado): so we close off

boxy (alfred.kelberry): i think a lot of them didn't expect to find themselves in this situation

Zen (zen.arado): most city folk wouldn't even see the homeless

Gaya Ethaniel: We don't want more problems, whatever seems like problems ...

leaping panther (darren.islar): but most people try to compare themselves with those people, saying, oh

I'm not like him, I'm not that far gone, instead of opening up and looking at their own fears

Zen (zen.arado): it could happen frighteningly easily

Zen (zen.arado): marriage breakup, illness...

Gaya Ethaniel: Yes ...

leaping panther (darren.islar): punishing others for being scared ourselves

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): The awareness that homelessness could happen easily might help us to become more empathetic.

leaping panther (darren.islar): /me nods

boxy (alfred.kelberry): zen, yes, we don't notice what we get used to. including our close friends and relatives too sometimes...

Zen (zen.arado): yes

Zen (zen.arado): or more withdrawn

boxy (alfred.kelberry): taking for granted

Gaya Ethaniel: I'm not sure if that's getting used to ...

leaping panther (darren.islar): (sorry need a little break)

Gaya Ethaniel: A bit like becoming numb right?

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): I was taking care of myself, actually.

Gaya Ethaniel: np

Zen (zen.arado): realizing that fear is a preventative for empathy

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): by giving the homeless man money for his story.

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): because I'd realized that i could not walk the streets of New York without crying./

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): so i decided to do something for MYSELF there.

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): That's why I gave the man money.

boxy (alfred.kelberry): gaya, if you live in a city and see homeless people every other day - you stop

noticing them. your mind just stops paying attention.

Zen (zen.arado): if you lived in NY you would have become hard probably

Zen (zen.arado): yes

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): I also told him that, of course.

Gaya Ethaniel: Not necessarily ... I still notice them after so many years. Often they smile at me ... sometimes stop me to say just hi:) Bruce (bruce.mowbray): i hope not, Zen. boxy (alfred.kelberry): gaya, that's nice:) Zen (zen.arado): I had a problem with a guy on Facebook recently Bruce (bruce.mowbray): yes. Gaya Ethaniel: They just want to say hi sometimes you know ... not even wanting money. Bruce (bruce.mowbray): who's to say that our condition is really better off than theirs? Zen (zen.arado): a black guy who lived in Uganda boxy (alfred.kelberry): i'd stop you to say hi too:) Bruce (bruce.mowbray): ;-) Bruce (bruce.mowbray): ha ha! Gaya Ethaniel::) boxy (alfred.kelberry): yes, having a conversation Gaya Ethaniel: Indeed Bruce, we can't say. Bruce (bruce.mowbray): /me listens to Zen. Zen (zen.arado): he friended me boxy (alfred.kelberry): bruce, yet, he'd swap with you in a second, i think Zen (zen.arado): and kept wanting to chat boxy (alfred.kelberry): zen, oh, you mean in sl? Zen (zen.arado): then he told me that his brother and sister needed money for education... Zen (zen.arado): on Facebook boxy (alfred.kelberry): ah Zen (zen.arado): did I know anyone who could send them money? Zen (zen.arado): and could I send some? Zen (zen.arado): so what do you do? Gaya Ethaniel: hm ... just say no? Zen (zen.arado): yeh Zen (zen.arado): you don't know what he would do with the money Zen (zen.arado): maybe he makes a living by friending people that way Bruce (bruce.mowbray): If it's really a gift, then you don't care what he does with the money. Zen (zen.arado): so I didn't send him any money boxy (alfred.kelberry): maybe he's your neighbor:) Bruce (bruce.mowbray): I wouldn't have either, Zen. Zen (zen.arado): so am I lacking in empathy? Gaya Ethaniel: hm ... no, I'd done the same. leaping panther (darren.islar): no Zen (is picking up again) Bruce (bruce.mowbray): First, have empathy for yourself. . . Bruce (bruce.mowbray): This is necessary -- first--leaping panther (darren.islar): we can't overlook the whole world Bruce (bruce.mowbray): know your own values and your own boundaries... Zen (zen.arado): this applies to us all in a way Bruce (bruce.mowbray): THEN, consider empathy for others. boxy (alfred.kelberry): right, bruce Zen (zen.arado): cos we know there are people starving in many countries

Zen (zen.arado): though we do send money from time to time leaping panther (darren.islar): yes zen, but money won't help boxy (alfred.kelberry): zen, 1 billion vs almost 6 to be exact Zen (zen.arado): but we still retain our own wealth leaping panther (darren.islar): we need to reconsider the way we live to overcome the problems of these days give all of your worldly possessions to help the starving... Bruce (bruce.mowbray): or you might not.

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): and... when you have empathy for yourself, you might discover that you need to

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): Empathy is not either/or morality.

Zen (zen.arado): Jesus was very specific about giving your money to the poor

leaping panther (darren.islar): we still distract more money from those countries then we give

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): he had a specific audience, too.

Zen (zen.arado): though he also said 'the poor you will always have among you'

Zen (zen.arado): so empathy with wisdom..

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): Strange thing that some of the happiest people are living in some of the poorest countries.

Zen (zen.arado): yes:)

boxy (alfred.kelberry): you can't fix the problem of poverty without changing culture

leaping panther (darren.islar): there is a lot that has been said about the poor by many teachers

Zen (zen.arado): we are so wrapped up in our possessions

leaping panther (darren.islar): and they seem to conflict each other

Gaya Ethaniel: They don't have much to protect ... no need for CCTV:P

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): You cannot fix anything without fixing yourself.

leaping panther (darren.islar): but I guess they don't:)

boxy (alfred.kelberry): gaya:)

Zen (zen.arado)::)

leaping panther (darren.islar): CCTV??

Gaya Ethaniel: Some houses have them ...

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): ;-)\

boxy (alfred.kelberry): i imagine how many tapes of me are stored in various places:)

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): closed circuit TV.

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): surveillance TV's.

Gaya Ethaniel: lol

leaping panther (darren.islar): ah...:)

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): There are THOUSANDS of them in the United Kingdom.

Gaya Ethaniel: mhm

leaping panther (darren.islar): bosy! what have you been doing ??:)))

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): literally thousands.

Zen (zen.arado): they don't have in the US?

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): oh yes, in US also.

Gaya Ethaniel: We have the most CCTV in the world I think Zen.

boxy (alfred.kelberry): darren, living in a city:)

Zen (zen.arado): yeh

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): where are you, gaya!, if I might ask.

leaping panther (darren.islar): :) boxy Zen (zen.arado): big brother Zen (zen.arado): 1984 is here boxy (alfred.kelberry): and we got used to them too Bruce (bruce.mowbray): I thought Gaya was in England. Gaya Ethaniel: So ... time to discuss about next week's topic ... I know some of you like this unstructured format, wonder if some wants something different like a theme over few weeks? Gaya Ethaniel: Yep I am. Zen (zen.arado): I am watching all of you on my screen:) Bruce (bruce.mowbray): ;-) Gaya Ethaniel: :P leaping panther (darren.islar): hahaha Zen:) Bruce (bruce.mowbray): sure, Gaya, that sounds good. boxy (alfred.kelberry): um...
