Julie Bluebird (lolli.bluebird): Ok, so we've all moved around:))

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): Hey, Zen!

Zon Kwan: zen heya Zen (zen.arado): Hi all FcSeeker: Hello Zen

Zen (zen.arado): how is everyone?

Zon Kwan: a bit ashamed

Violet (ataraxia.azemus): I'm in a shameful state:)

Zen (zen.arado): shame

FcSeeker: having peacefull mind Bruce (bruce.mowbray): (your genes?) Zon Kwan: fc are you allright?

FcSeeker: no, but I have peace in my mind

Zon Kwan: lol

Zen (zen.arado): if nothing can disturb that....

FcSeeker: (and feel love in my chest) Zen (zen.arado): deep down is the peace

FcSeeker: yes

FcSeeker: so nothing can desturb it atm

Zen (zen.arado): the surface events come and go

Violet (ataraxia.azemus): So, I think we're all on the same page, but just for the record, we're discussing

shame as an "edge" experience and as a way of knowing...

Violet (ataraxia.azemus): Hi Cal:) Bruce (bruce.mowbray): Hey, Cal!

Zen (zen.arado): Hi Cal:)

FcSeeker: Hello Cal

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): EXCELLENT essay, Cal! Julie Bluebird (lolli.bluebird): waves to Cal:) Violet (ataraxia.azemus): I liked it, too:)

Calvino Rabeni::))))))))

Zen (zen.arado): quickly looks it up

Violet (ataraxia.azemus): http://wiki.playasbeing.org/Guardian..._Knowing/Shame

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): thanks, Atari.

Violet (ataraxia.azemus)::)

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): /me waits for Cal to enter and join us.

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): /me waves to Cal.

Zon Kwan: cal

Zen (zen.arado): yeh good report

Violet (ataraxia.azemus): I liked the association of shame with empathy...that reminded me of an idea I'd

heard of a number of years ago...

Zen (zen.arado): listens

Violet (ataraxia.azemus): Of our identification "expanding" or "contracting"....to think of it in physical

terms makes sense to me

Violet (ataraxia.azemus): When I'm ashamed, I want to burrow into myself; when I empathize, I'm

becoming bigger than I was

Zen (zen.arado): yeh

Zen (zen.arado): want to get away from the group or person or idea that caused us to feel shame

Zen (zen.arado): so shame is caused by ohters?

 $Bruce\ (bruce.mowbray): /me\ ponders "\ p[ysical\ terms"\ and\ thinks\ about\ how\ folks\ consider\ their\ body\ to$

be "inadequate" -- and are ashamed about their "inadequacy."

Zen (zen.arado): from us breaking the group norm they have set up for us?

Zon Kwan: connection..yes ..is relevant here

Zon Kwan: shame comes from a feeling of separateness

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): , I was so skinny that I couldn't bear to be seen on the basketball court. I didn't go out even for intramural basketball, because I knew that the girls would burst into laughter as soon as I ran out there in my jersey.

Zen (zen.arado): so much shame seems to be not acting or fitting a 'norm'?

Zon Kwan: shame is caused by one feeling being separate

Zen (zen.arado): yeh but thre feeling of separateness comes after the shame?

Zon Kwan: same time

Violet (ataraxia.azemus): Hi Ags and Aphrodite:)

Aggers (agatha.macbeth): Boo! Aggers (agatha.macbeth): :PP Julie Bluebird (lolli.bluebird): EEK!

Aphrodite Macbain: Boo!

Zen (zen.arado): Hi Aggers and Aph Aggers (agatha.macbeth): Evening all

Zon Kwan: hi agatha

Aggers (agatha.macbeth): Not sure if you would be here

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): Hey, aggers! Aphrodite Macbain: hello everyone

Zen (zen.arado): or shame is not matchig up to a standard we have set up for ourselves?

Aphrodite Macbain: Bruce is an airplane Aggers (agatha.macbeth): Or Jesus :p

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): Yes, you finally figures out that I am an airplane.

Aggers (agatha.macbeth): TWI?

Violet (ataraxia.azemus): I think shame as a reaction to social norms makes sense...

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): When you were born, you brought a vibrant, extravagant, excitable, noisy, many-sided nature with you from eons of vegetable life, reptile life, mammal life, lion life, hunter life, aboriginal life – all of it lived before your human birth.

Violet (ataraxia.azemus): How shameful:)

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): You brought it all and gave it to your parents as a gift, and they didn't want it. Instead, they wanted a NICE boy.

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): They said, "Can't you be quiet? Why won't you be a nice boy like the others?" Bruce (bruce.mowbray): ?" We figured out what kind of child they wanted, and we created a false self to please them. So your survival instinct did the right thing. It made up a false self and you survived.

Zen (zen.arado): yes

Calvino Rabeni: Nice, Bruce - yes, before and within human life

Aphrodite Macbain: Do you think shame is culturally determined and not natural?

Zen (zen.arado): parents often try to make children ashamed don't they? 'shame on you' 'you should be ashamed of yourself'

Aphrodite Macbain: It's a means of controlling them

Violet (ataraxia.azemus): wb Zon:)

Zon Kwan: basically natural, but culturally colored in expressions

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): Cal's essay suggests that "shame" might be adaptive to survival.

Violet (ataraxia.azemus): Shame is often about control or conformity, yes...

Calvino Rabeni: I think we all feel victimized by that process .. but also do a lot to create it and play both "sides"

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): which serves the "Group's" survival and therefore yours, also.

Zen (zen.arado): shame in a nutshell Violet:)

Aphrodite Macbain: I wonder how we survive bettr with shame?

Zon Kwan: control Zon Kwan: is needed Calvino Rabeni: yes

Zen (zen.arado): or could we do without it?#

Aphrodite Macbain: We become more socialized and adaptable to our society

Calvino Rabeni: regulation, finding a happy medium

Zon Kwan: not yet

Violet (ataraxia.azemus): Sometimes we can....

Zen (zen.arado): good to check that our shame is valid I think

Violet (ataraxia.azemus): Sometimes shame doesn't really serve a purpose except to hold us back...there's

that edge to it

Zon Kwan: we can..but others,,,

Aphrodite Macbain: it goes along with embarassment & self consciousness

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): . For example, a child can get caught shoplifting. I did – very shaming. --- That experience of shaming served both the society and me quite well.

Calvino Rabeni: I think nothing happens without it making sense to multiple reasons and purposes

Zen (zen.arado): we can still feel shame from outmoded moral values

Zon Kwan: yes...shame prevents persons to grow too

Violet (ataraxia.azemus): wb FcSeeker:)

FcSeeker: thank you

Aphrodite Macbain: I guess it is tied in with edges. When we go beyond the edge, we are punished by

society and feel shame

Calvino Rabeni: Shame could be seen like a gardener pruning the tree of desire so that it grows in certain

ways and not all over the place

Aggers (agatha.macbeth): Hello FC:)

FcSeeker: Hello Agatha

Aphrodite Macbain: Nice metaphor Cal

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): without shaming, could the society survive?

Aphrodite Macbain: Hi FC Zon Kwan: not this society Bruce (bruce.mowbray): wb, Fc.

FcSeeker: Hi Aphrodite

FcSeeker: ty Bruce

Zon Kwan: but a more evolved could

Zen (zen.arado): but it is ust one mechanism of societal control

Aphrodite Macbain: Hi FC GTSY

Violet (ataraxia.azemus): I like that image....but I have a fondness for messy trees, too:)

Julie Bluebird (lolli.bluebird): ha ha ha

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): Look at how the Congress is trying to shame the other side -- supposing that by doing so their own party will survive.

FcSeeker: GTSY too Aphrodite

Aphrodite Macbain: Zen, that implies that shame is created by society and is not biologically dtermined

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): ridiculous -- when everyone goes down the tubes.

Zon Kwan: shame has levels

Zen (zen.arado): newspapers dig up dirt about ppl to make them feel shame?

Aphrodite Macbain: HUh? Aphrodite Macbain: Brice?

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): it's an American thing -- not to worry.

Zen (zen.arado): or to make the ppl who didn't do what they did feel better about themselves

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): INHERITED SHAME is inherited shame from the far past. Shame of that sort is connected with certain secrets that your grandparents kept. For example, an uncle embezzled money; an aunt had a mental breakdown and was in an institution for a while; a child was retarded.

Aphrodite Macbain: Yes. Zen (zen.arado): true Aph

Aphrodite Macbain: Shame can be felt even if their is no "fault" attached to it. Like having slaves in one's ancestry

Zen (zen.arado): wonder how much of it is genetic

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): /me listens for "levels" to shame.

Zen (zen.arado): maybe only the faculty of being able to experience it

Violet (ataraxia.azemus): Sometimes we feel shame over things we perceive to be taboo, when no one else around us feels that way...

Zon Kwan: shame has it roots in being a separate ego..a metaphysical level

FcSeeker: is there something wrong with one who dont feel him/herself to be ashame of such things?

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): shame as an I-process, Zon?

Zon Kwan: yes

Zen (zen.arado): ha could be Zon...no ego no shame?

Aphrodite Macbain: Zon, can you say more?

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): excellent point, Zen.... no ego no shame.

Zen (zen.arado): (no woman no cry)

Violet (ataraxia.azemus)::)

Zon Kwan: yup zen

Calvino Rabeni: levels to shame .. hmmm, for instance if there's just a slight breakdown in rapport with a social connection, one starts to feel just a little inappropriate, and seeks to adjust things, or if that doesn't work, feels out of place, that's a shame-like level that's in the moment and not too intense

Aphrodite Macbain: Public shaming must be the worst.

Aphrodite Macbain: /me thinks of many politicians

Violet (ataraxia.azemus): There is also shame for things we've done (or haven't done) and for things we

are...

Zen (zen.arado): what should we do about shame?

Zon Kwan: shame means i compare myself against a bigger whole

Zon Kwan: and feel lacking

Aphrodite Macbain: Good question Zen

Calvino Rabeni: One really shadowed shame is ... what are we collectively, doing to the planet

Zen (zen.arado): check its validity first I think

Aphrodite Macbain: hmmm and whether we feel shame or anger

Calvino Rabeni: so, from in-the-moment with another person, to the big picture of the human species in

the planet .. a lot of levels to it

Aphrodite Macbain: Yes Zen but how?

Violet (ataraxia.azemus): Yes...it's good to ask *why* we feel ashamed

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): /me thinks of the Scarlet Letter.

Zon Kwan: watch it

Violet (ataraxia.azemus): Good point, Cal:) Zen (zen.arado): it is often conditioned

Zon Kwan: as long as i am identified with my ego there will be shame

Aphrodite Macbain: bt=y what Zen? Zon Kwan: nothing to do about it

Zen (zen.arado): oh from parents, friends, what we read

Aphrodite Macbain: Perhaps talking about it? Apologizing? Acting upon it?

Aphrodite Macbain: Would that make the shame disappear? Zen (zen.arado): but sometimes we should be ashamed Zon? Aphrodite Macbain: only if we can take some sort of action

Zon Kwan: no

Zen (zen.arado): yeh deciding on more appropriate behaviour if the same type of situation arises again?

Aphrodite Macbain: otherwise it would sit and fester!

Zon Kwan: we should correct our behaviour

Zon Kwan: but not feel ashamed

Violet (ataraxia.azemus): Sometimes shame can point us toward a better path; sometimes it keeps us stuck

in a rut

Aphrodite Macbain: yes, if it is appropriate

Zen (zen.arado): but the shame is a motivator too?

Aphrodite Macbain: yes. but to what?

Calvino Rabeni: guilt seems more situational and open to remedial actions ... shame seems to involve ongoing issues of who one *is* rather than what one *does*

Zen (zen.arado): yes Vi...that's why I think validity checking is good

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): Ego and shame: The idea is that if by 14, you've been shamed well enough by other people, you won't need an external person to shame you anymore. You'll do it yourself.

Aphrodite Macbain: yes Zen

Violet (ataraxia.azemus): Yes, Cal

Aphrodite Macbain: Where did that idea come from Bruce?

Zen (zen.arado): but we are ashamed of our actions sometimes Cal?

Calvino Rabeni: Yes Bruce, we internalize problematic things to sort of deal with them in advance rather

than bumping into them unawarely

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): It came from Robert Bly's SEVEN SOURCES OF SHAME.

Zen (zen.arado): something I said that I shouldn't have for instance...

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): (as have most of my other comments.)

Aggers (agatha.macbeth): Why seven I wonder?

Aphrodite Macbain: Thanks Bruce

Violet (ataraxia.azemus): Thanks, Bruce:)

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): 7 is the only number that is not ashamed of itself.

 $Calvino\ Rabeni: I\ think\ Zen\ we'd\ be\ a shamed\ of\ being\ the\ person\ who\ did\ the\ actions,\ there's\ a\ distinction$

there

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): It never got to be 14,

Aggers (agatha.macbeth): Why? Aggers (agatha.macbeth): Ah

Violet (ataraxia.azemus): Because it 8 9?

Aggers (agatha.macbeth): :)
Violet (ataraxia.azemus): Ah :)

Aphrodite Macbain: Huh.

Aphrodite Macbain: /me scratches her head

Aggers (agatha.macbeth): /me thinks of a Shakespeare play

Aphrodite Macbain: /me thinks of many Shakespear plays

Aggers (agatha.macbeth): He only said it in one:p

Zen (zen.arado): so we resolve to be a better person in future?

Zon Kwan: we make errors..we correct...to feel shame is only a hindrance

Zen (zen.arado): don't see a great distinction though

Calvino Rabeni: that's interesting Zen

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): Is that the Edge, Zen?

Zen (zen.arado): but shame is a pointer

Violet (ataraxia.azemus): I mostly agree, Zon

Aphrodite Macbain: sometimes others make us feel shameful inappropriately

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): a wake-up call?

Zen (zen.arado): if we didn't fell shame we wouldn't feel any need to improve our behaviour

Violet (ataraxia.azemus): Yes, Zen

Aphrodite Macbain: we have to decide whether we should feel it or not

Calvino Rabeni: Being vs doing ... maybe it it's more about being .. meaning deeper and more fundamental,

it feels like shame; whereas things that are external, about doing, we can feel distanced from

Calvino Rabeni: and say its about the action, not the person

Zen (zen.arado): I'm epeating myself I'm ashamed to say:)

Aggers (agatha.macbeth): Wonder why Mila has hung her washing out at the pavilion?

Zen (zen.arado): (ashamed of my bad typing too)

Aphrodite Macbain: Aggie??

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): Re this ego thing -- If we do not get a response from the "outer" world, we might

feel indequate -- "I've I'd been adequate, they would have responded to me."

Aggers (agatha.macbeth): Hiya Mil

Mila (milakel): aga girl:)

Aggers (agatha.macbeth): Happy washday

Violet (ataraxia.azemus): I think shame is related to being....even our actions can make us ashamed of who

we are ("I'm a bad person because ___") Zen (zen.arado): I can feel ashamed about my body FcSeeker: (thinks that one can want to improve ones behavier still even dont feel ashame) Mila (milakel): hi:) Violet (ataraxia.azemus): Hi Mila:) Bruce (bruce.mowbray): Hey, Mila! Aphrodite Macbain: Hey Mila Zen (zen.arado): Hi Mila:) Zon Kwan: see ya Aggers (agatha.macbeth): Bye Zon Aphrodite Macbain: yes Zen. Aphrodite Macbain: only if they survive Cal;

Aggers (agatha.macbeth): They were vegans

Aphrodite Macbain: /me giggles Aphrodite Macbain: so, shame...

Calvino Rabeni: yeah they survived the plane crash ... knew perhaps life wasn't fair to spare them and take the others

Aphrodite Macbain: I wonder whether there are societies that dont have shame

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): I felt that I was somehow responsible for the assassinations of both JFK and his brother Robert -- because I was in those sities at the time -- and I saw JFK at the airport in Dallas when he arrived..

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): cities*

Mila (milakel): shame is good in retrospect as experience to learn from, but not helpful in resolving the issue.

Julie Bluebird (lolli.bluebird): Really Bruce?

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): It took me years to work myself out of that.

Violet (ataraxia.azemus): I agree, Mila

Aphrodite Macbain: usually you feel it after the fact, not before

Calvino Rabeni: Not sure, I'd be surprised to learn of a shame-free society

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): guit through physical presence. - - - maybe like the plane crash survivors.

Aphrodite Macbain: Were we shame free when we were hippies?

Zen (zen.arado): group shame

Zen (zen.arado): tried to be Aph:)

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): /me was the only resident of Berkeley inthe 60's who was not a hippie.

Calvino Rabeni: No, Aphro, we wer probably ashamed of having profits and good clothes or whatever

Aphrodite Macbain: love is not having to say you're sorry...

Mila (milakel): bruce, interesting. i think it's your sense of connectedness probably.

Violet (ataraxia.azemus): Oh, you're famous, Bruce:)

Zen (zen.arado): yeh ashamed of being conformist

Aphrodite Macbain: yay Bruce

Calvino Rabeni: but it was so easy to be "uncool":)

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): /me is also the only American male who has never played a computeized game --

but is not ashamed of it.

Calvino Rabeni: Hey Bruce, I never did either:)

Aphrodite Macbain: I know a few others...

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): yeppers!

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): YAYYYY for Cal and Bruce! Zen (zen.arado): I was never keen on them either

Calvino Rabeni: hehe

Zen (zen.arado): confession time

Aphrodite Macbain: They play in SL instead

Bruce (bruce.mowbray): and Zen, too! Mila (milakel): wait, bruce... sl *is* a computerized game!:) Aphrodite Macbain: exactly Zen (zen.arado): no it isn't MIla Bruce (bruce.mowbray): not for moi, it isn't.
